
Subject: - Submission Immovable Property Return (IPR) for the year 2022 (as on 31.12.2022) by the officers/officials of CSS/CSSS/CSCS - reg.

In terms of Rule 18 of CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964, IPR should be submitted by all the CSS/CSSS/CSCS officers/officials through Web Based Cadre Management System which is hosted at cscms.nic.in. A copy of the print out (IPR submitted online) duly signed, should also be submitted to CS.I (PR/CMS) Section, which is the custodian of Immovable Property Return (IPR) of Under Secretary and above Group A officers. SO, ASO, PS, PA, PS and other group B and C officers of this Ministry will also submit the print out (IPR) duly signed to Vigilance Section (MS), Ministry of Labour and Employment, latest by **31.01.2023**.

2. It is also informed that non-submission of IPR within the stipulated date, would invite the denial of vigilance clearance for empanelment, deputation and applying to sensitive posts and assignment to training programme (except mandatory training) as the IPR status needs to be checked for the said purpose(s).

3. It is, therefore, requested that all the CSS/CSSS/CSCS Officers file their Immovable Property Return (IPR) for the year 2022 (as on 31.12.2022) well in time, latest by 31.01.2023, through Web Based Cadre Management System only. IPRs received beyond the stipulated date, shall not be regarded as conforming to the extant guidelines.
