Percentage is same for all quarters as all eligible EPS members get benefit of 1.16% as per entitlement. A target of 100% can be kept, however, it would be effective only when membership of EPS is made mandatory upto wage ceiling for all members.

@Data of total Work Force employed in formal sector is not available with EPFO. Moreover, it has no linkage for providing Minimum Pension support by the Government in respect of poor pensioners drawing less than Rs. 1,000 pension from EPS, 95.

^{**}It captures the number of beneficiaries whose pension as per formula is less than Rs. 1,000/- (due to low contribution or less pensionable service). The pension is brought to Rs. 1,000/- by Government Contribution. Hence, accurate target setting is difficult. Target of 25% has been set by taking numerator as 19,87,338 (achievement of FY 2023-24) and denominator as 78,66,628 (as per data on EPFO Dashboard).

[^]The target can be kept as 100% subject to (i) only those pensioners be treated as beneficiaries who are receiving pension after submitting their DLCs i.e. as soon as the pension is stopped for want of DLC, that pensioner shall not be considered as a beneficiary; and (ii) the target of 100% may not be achieved as there would be certain cases of updation of Life Certificate by their submission in paper form like medical compulsions, etc.

*Presently, the PMSYM scheme and NCS portal are integrated with e-Shram portal. The number of e-Shram registrants can be provided. However, as these are demand driven schemes, no targets can be fixed.

^The parameter is not appropriate as this depends on the concerned Ministries / Departments. Moreover, e-Shram data is publicly available on e-Shram dashboard and www.data.gov.in. Thus, all Ministries / Departments have access to this information and may be using for different purposes.
