



## Shri Bhupender Yadav highlights government initiatives to eliminate discrimination in labour markets promoting social justice

Shri Yadav said for greater inclusion of women in our workforce India has increased paid maternity leave from 12 weeks to 26 weeks, made provision for mandatory crèche facilities in establishments having 50 or more employees, permitting women workers in the night shifts with adequate safety measures.
