- **3856 Physical Files Weeded Out:** Our rigorous efforts in decluttering and organizing records have resulted in significant progress towards a more efficient workflow.
- **100% Implementation of E-Office:** Embracing modern technology, we have fully integrated the E-Office system to reduce paperwork and streamline processes.
- **99% Pending Public Grievances Disposed Of:** Timely resolution of public grievances remains a top priority, and we are proud to have addressed a substantial number of them (140761 out of 142207)
- **99% Pending Public Grievance Appeals Disposed Of:** Ensuring that the concerns of the public are heard and acted upon promptly is integral to our mission (32158 out of 32442)
- **References from MPs:** 81 % of references received from MPs have been disposed of (70 out of 86 receipts)
- **Cleanliness campaign** conducted on more than 1309 sites.
