G.S.R..... - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution and in supersession of the Combined Recruitment Rules for Group 'C' & 'D' posts under Labour Welfare Organisation notified in the gazette of India dated 22nd September, 1992, where the (i) Mica Mines Labour Welfare Organization (Group 'C' and Group 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1977 (ii) Iron Ore Mines Labour Welfare Fund (Class III and IV posts) Recruitment Rules, 1967 and (iii) Limestone and Dolomite Mines Labour Welfare Fund (Group 'C' and 'D' posts) condition of services and Recruitment Rules, 1976 (iv) Iron Ore Mines Labour Welfare Fund (Group 'C' posts) Recruitment Rules 1977 as amended from time to time are superseded, except as respects things done or omitted to be done following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Stenographer Grade III (Group 'C' post) under the Labour Welfare Organisations, Ministry of Labour and Employment, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement:** - (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Labour and Employment, Labour Welfare Organisations, Stenographer Grade III (Group 'C' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2019.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
2. **Application:** - These rules shall apply in the Labour Welfare Organisations under Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India.
3. **Number of post, Classification and scale of Pay:** - Number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in rows (2) to (4) of the schedule I annexed to these rules. The Labour Welfare Organisations-wise bifurcation of said post is annexed as schedule II.
4. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification etc.:** - The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the schedule I.
5. **Disqualification:** - No Person, -
 - (a) who, has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person.shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax:** - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. **Saving:** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

1. Stenographers under the Central Government –

(a) (i) holding analogous posts on a regular basis; or with 3 years regular service in post in the Level 2 of pay matrix or equivalent; and

(b) Possessing a speed of 80 words per minute in Stenography and 40 words per minute in typing (English/Hindi).

2. Departmental Lower Division Clerks with 3 years regular service in the grade and possessing a speed of 80 words per minute in Stenography and 40 words per minutes in typing (English/Hindi) will also be considered and in case, he is selected for appointment to the post, the same shall be deemed to have been filled by promotion.

(The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in

the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed 3 years.)


