The functions of the Research Advisory Committee (RAC) in respect of research projects on drinking water supply and sanitation in rural areas are as follows:-

- 1. To generate new ideas for research & development and fix priority for R&D project and decide thrust areas.
- 2. To identify field problems from the user departments and community organizations viz. Non Governmental Organizations (NG05,) Voluntary agencies. etc.
- 3. Identify Institutions and Scientists for specific R&D projects and invite them to submit proposals.
- 4. Technical monitoring of hydrological systems in various sensitive zones of the country. The quantitative & qualitative aspects of drinking water

sources to be monitored. RAC would identify the institutions and organizations that will be involved into this technical monitoring.

- 5. Help the identified scientists to formulate intersectoral and multidisciplina4ry research projects relevant to the Mission.
- 6. To scrutinize and recommend individual research project proposals to the Government of India for sanction /rejection..
- 7. To review the progress of the ongoing Research & Development (R&D) projects and suggest midcourse correction, if any.
- 8. To evaluate the findings of the completed Research & Development projects and suggest follow up actions.
- 9. To suggest norms to institute Mission sponsored" Water fellowships" and "chairs" in Universities and Research & Development (R&D) organizations.
- 10. To help the Mission to organize regional, national and international workshops, annual R&D review sessions and National Water Congresses to be sponsored by the Mission.
- 11. To help the Mission to prepare specialized and emerging science and technology related documents of current interest.
- 12. To help and advice the Mission on all such matters which will help the Mission to promote, adopt, generate, modify any science & technology as well as research and developmental activities with specific reference to Rural Water Supply and Sanitation sectors.
- The proposals which are found prima-facie suitable by the Screening Committee (RAC) consisting of Additional Adviser(PHE) and all the technical officers of this Mission may be presented before the Research Advisory Committee (RAC) by the concerned Principal Investigator.
- The Principal Investigator from Non Governmental Organization (NGO's) who make the presentation before the Screening Committee (RAC) and /or Research Advisory Committee (RAC) may be offered II AC train fare from his working place to Delhi or place of meeting and back.
- 3. The decision of Research Advisory Committee (RAC) shall be final on matters regarding administrative, financial sanction, duration of the project etc.
