New Delhi, the 9th October 1958

G.S.R. 946.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Working Journalists (Fixation of Rates of Wages) Act, 1958 (29 of 1958), the Central Government hereby makes the following amendment in the Working Journalists (Fixation of Rates of Wages) Rules, 1958, namely:—

In the said Rules, after rule 2, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“2A. Proceedings before the Committee shall ordinarily be open to the public:

Provided that the Committee may at any stage direct that any witness shall be examined, or its proceedings shall be held, in camera.”
